Wales has suffered from a slower productivity growth since the global financial crisis of 2007-09 and a persistent productivity gap with the rest of the UK. To date, this has proved resistant to policy intervention.

Mae Cymru wedi dioddef o dwf cynhyrchiant arafach ers argyfwng ariannol byd-eang 2007-09 a bwlc cynhyrchiant parhaus gyda gweddill y DU. Hyd yn hyn, mae hyn wedi gwrrthsefyll ymyrraeth polisi.

The Wales Productivity Forum, supported by Cardiff University, seeks to identify the key potential drivers of improved productivity performance so that the business community and policymakers alike can look to build back a prosperous Wales for all.
